Early in 1895: Publication by Elkin Mathews, London, of *Dublin Verses*, written by former students of Trinity College Dublin, and edited by Henry Albert Hinkson (1865-1919), married to Katharine Tynan (1861-1931), with whom Wilde corresponded in late 1894, telling her: “Dear Mrs Hinkson, Your husband can print any poems of mine he likes in his anthology.” In fact, Hinkson re-published both “five poems by Willie Wilde” (1852-1899), Oscar’s elder brother, and “Requiescat”, “Sonnet on Approaching Italy”, “The True Knowledge”, “Theocritus”, and “The Dole of the King’s Daughter” by Oscar himself.
